

SCI Essential Information Leaflet 2006

SCI Great Yarmouth Mitre Ultimatch May Day Cup
Haven Seashore Holiday Park
Friday 28 April – Monday 1 May

How to get there: From Great Yarmouth take the A149 to Caister. Turn right at the 2nd set of lights signposted to the seafront and racecourse. Continue to the sea and turn left. Seashore is on the left.

- 1. Arrival:** You may arrive from 10am on Friday 28 April when all bars, restaurants, shops and leisure facilities will be open. Your accommodation will not be ready for occupation until 4pm
- 2. Keys:** Available for collection between 4pm - 5pm in The Trade Winds Show Bar venue which is situated in the main entertainments complex. After 5pm keys can be collected from main reception. Keys will only be given to the adult in charge of each individual accommodation unit (as per the SCI Accommodation Booking Details 2006 Form). Holiday Park passes and Presentation passes will be distributed at the same time. Accommodation keys, Holiday Park Passes & Presentation passes must be signed for by the adult in charge of each accommodation unit.
- 3. Bed Linen & Towels:** Bed linen is provided. Towels are not provided.
- 4. Player Registration Form 2006:** Please complete with the name & date of birth of every player in your festival team(s) and bring to the SCI check-in desk on arrival. One form per team. Photo identification is compulsory either in the form of your league i.d. registration card(s) or a valid passport. If a player does not have a league i.d. registration card or a valid passport a passport sized photo must be affixed to the SCI Player Registration Form and be supported with evidence in the form of a valid medical card or copy birth certificate. Do not return player registration forms to SCI.
- 5. Managers Meeting:** No Smoking. The SCI managers meeting is only open to team managers and will take place at 7pm on Friday 28 April in a venue to be advised on arrival at Seashore Holiday Park. The meeting will detail all football festival matters including introducing your SCI festival committee and presentation of your festival information folder which will detail your fixtures. Changing rooms, showers, toilet facilities, parking & catering are all available at the pitches. The pitches for age groups Under 7's to Under 11's 7-a-side mini-soccer are directly adjacent to The Holiday Park at Seashore (No driving is necessary). The pitches for age groups Under 11's to Under 14's 11-a-side are at Mill Lane in Great Yarmouth (as last year). Expect a 10 -15 minute drive to these pitches. Directions from The Holiday Park to the pitches at Mill Lane are attached overleaf.
- 6. Presentation:** No Smoking. SCI Gala Football Personality Presentations will take place from 6pm on the afternoon of Sunday 30 April in The Trade Winds Show Bar venue. There will be three separate Presentations at 6pm, 7.30pm & 9pm and you will be advised of your team's Presentation time on arrival at Seashore. Entry will be strictly by ticket only.
- 7. Official Photographer:** Barkers Photographic are the event's official photographer & will be photographing team groups & players during the tournament and at the Presentation(s). 01493 843399 or visit www.barkersphotographic.co.uk.
- 8. Supervision:** Children must be properly supervised at all times. Cases of misconduct by any members of your party (including adults) on the Holiday Park or at the football pitches will be reported to the festival committee. Misconduct may result in disciplinary action, including disqualification from the festival and / or reporting to your county and / or national FA. Any child found outside the Holiday Park entertainment complex or their accommodation unit(s) after 8.30pm must be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 or over. No child is allowed to leave the Holiday Park complex unaccompanied by an adult.
- 9. Football Kits:** Please be aware that other holiday makers do use the Holiday Park. As such SCI request that children do not wear their team colours around the Holiday Park or in the Holiday Park entertainment(s) complex. Please only wear team colours for travelling to & from and whilst playing football at the pitches. Please ensure that football boots are not worn inside the accommodation.

- 10. Alcohol:** SCI Youth Football Festivals operate a zero tolerance policy on under age drinking. No child is allowed to purchase or consume alcohol at an SCI Youth Football Festival. Adults are not allowed to buy alcohol for children under the age of 18 at an SCI Youth Football Festival and any team found guilty of this will be asked to leave the Holiday Park and be reported to their county F.A. for disciplinary action.
- 11. Damages:** Any damages to accommodation will be invoiced directly to your club. Playing of any ball games is strictly prohibited in the accommodation lanes / areas. If you find any fault(s) with your accommodation please report them to reception on arrival.
- 12. Departure:** Accommodation must be vacated by 10am on the day of departure.
